**Folke Rydén has won numerous international awards as a reporter producer and director. His documentaries have been aired around the world.**

In 1993, he was awarded the Grand Prize in Journalism - Sweden's foremost award for excellence in journalism.

Productions have been aired by more than 40 broadcasters, shown in over 30 countries and have garnered dozens of international awards.

Folke Rydén was born in 1958 in Uppsala, Sweden. With an MA in journalism from the University of Stockholm, he began working for Swedish national television in 1982.

The company is currently involved in documentaries, cinema releases and television series.

After a decade as a foreign correspondent with 7 years in the USA he is now based in Stockholm Sweden.

In 1995 Folke Rydén founded FRP AB, an independent production company producing film & television for the domestic and international market in current affairs, social issues, human rights, history, politics, science, environmental issues and sports.

Folke Rydén is also a popular lecturer, public speaker and moderator. In a characteristic and personal way Folke Rydén talks about a rapidly changing world from his own perspective as a reporter and filmmaker.
